After a year since the final peace accord was signed between the Colombian government and the guerrilla FARC-EP, Colombia's most successful peace process has launched its implementation. Even though women's participation and references to women in the final agreement have been exemplary, it is to evaluate the challenges that the implementation faces regarding the negotiated points with particular attention to women's rights contained in the accord.
