**Resolution 1922 (2010)****Adopted by the Security Council at its 6312th meeting, on  
12 May 2010***The Security Council,**Recalling* its resolutions and the statements of its President concerning Chad, the Central African Republic and the subregion, including resolutions 1769 (2007), 1778 (2007), 1834 (2008), 1861 (2009) and 1913 (2010),*Considering* the need to examine thoroughly the recommendations for a revised mandate of the United Nations Mission in the Central African Republic and in Chad (MINURCAT) included in the report of the Secretary-General (S/2010/217) of 29 April 2010,*Determining* that the situation in the region continues to constitute a threat to international peace and security,

1. *Decides* to extend until 26 May 2010 the mandate of MINURCAT as set out in resolution 1861 (2009), extended by resolution 1913 (2010);
  2. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
